

Privacy Policy

1. Acceptance of policy as condition of using www.nhsci.org

It is important for you to know the Privacy Policy (the "Policy") of the New Hampshire Chapter of Safari Club International ("NHSCI") before using any feature of www.nhsci.org (the "Web site").
